### INSTRUCTIONS FOR INTERCLUB HOSTING CLUBS

**The hosting clubs for class "A" - "B" - "SENIOR" interclub must conform to certain guidelines.**

- 1) The letter to the invited clubs captain must be sent a minimum of 4 weeks prior to the competition date.
- 2) **The following information must be specified in the letter :**
  - Available dates for the competing teams practice round. (as several players are still in the work force, flexibility is greatly appreciated)
  - If there are 2 courses, specify which course the match will be played.
  - **TEES** : which tees the competition will be played from.
  - Contact details in order to reserve the practice round, #tel, cell, email, along with deadline date/time to reserve.
  - Electric cart fee
- 3) **Competition day details :**
  - Captains meeting time, specify
  - Competition start time, specify

#### **Captains meeting :**

- Competition conditions and local rules
- Game conditions : summer or winter rules
- Departure tees (as per practice round)
- Pin placement, if applicable
- Advise of particularities on any give hole
- Official on site in the event of dispute, name and #cell to contact

#### **Electric Cart**

- Cart fee (\$)
- How many carts accepted per foursome on competition day

#### **What is offered to players and captain :**

- Details for BRUNCH or DINNER...
- Caddies-companions, fee for meals

**On competition day, it is important to adhere to the instructions that have been given to the participants  
Ex. : Departure tees, # of carts per foursome etc.**
